



Pavilion Meeting

15/04/2024

1. The meeting was opened at 19:00
2. *General Update*
The results from the online survey in the summer were discussed. Overall, there seems to be widespread support for the idea.
3. *Quotations for Costing*
After considering the quotes for a quantity surveyor, it was decided that the working group would recommend to council that Ravenslade was appointed to do the work at a maximum cost of £1500 to allow for amendments needed and a budget of £10,000 set aside for getting the project to planning application submission stage. **The Clerk to add these items to the agenda.**
4. *Two Final Options*
The essentials for a smaller scale project were identified. **Cllr Stewart to draw up a small-scale pavilion design.**
5. *Location*
A final proposed location of next to the play park was decided upon.
6. *Swimming Pool*
Cllr Walrond and Cllr Stewart proposed that it be considered that a community pool was constructed as part of the pavilion design. This would negate the need for the school pool to be repaired etc and provide the community with a pool that all could use. The Clerk expressed concerns around running costs and management of such a facility. **Cllr Stewart to speak to the Headteacher about the practicalities of this proposal.**
7. *Grants*
There was a discussion around how the pavilion could be funded and what it would entail.
8. *Community Engagement*
It was felt that at the moment, further community engagement was not needed but would take place once costs had been established and the council has decided whether to proceed.
